## **Minutes of the Meeting held on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2011**

The Chairman, Cllr Moriarty welcomed everyone to the meeting and invited the members of the public to speak. Mrs Holland advised that a group of people in the village have arranged a meeting on 8th November to discuss plans for celebrating the Diamond Jubilee in 2012.
